



ADDINK COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD

Purpose:

The Addink Community Service Award is presented annually to one individual, or family, who has made a positive impact on the community through volunteerism.

Award Criteria:

The award recognizes and honors an exceptional individual or family that makes volunteerism and community service a way of life. The award recipient exemplifies the best in volunteering – a sense of caring and responsibility for others, for the betterment of the local community and beyond. Specifically, the winner will be someone who:

- Gives freely and unselfishly of their time to community activities;
- Inspires others to serve and acts as a role model;
- Has a positive impact upon the direction and success of community projects, programs or individuals;
- Improves the lives of others.

Award History:

The Addink Community Service Award was created in 2012 to recognize one individual, or family, who has made a positive impact on the community through volunteerism. The award is named after Barb and Ken Addink of Sioux Center in recognition of their 30-plus years of involvement in community activities. In honor of its namesake, Addink Community Service Award winners are recognized for giving freely and unselfishly to community activities, inspiring others to serve and having a positive impact on the success of community projects, programs and individuals.

Award Presentation + Recognition:

The award will be presented at Promise Community Health Center's annual "An Evening of Promise" celebration event. Promise's 2017 event will be **Thursday, Nov. 2**, at Terrace View Event Center in Sioux Center. The honoree will be notified prior to the event and recognized publicly through various media outlets.

Eligibility:

Any individual who is not an employee, current board member or an immediate family member of an employee or board member of Promise Community Health Center is eligible.

Nominating Procedure:

Anyone may nominate. Major elements of a nominee's contributions will include the amount of time spent volunteering and performing community service; the level of effort expended; initiative demonstrated; and quality and overall impact of the work performed.
